



## RAC Bucks



*What are RAC Bucks?* It's "Money" the Rochester Archery Club uses to pay club members for working for the club.

*What kind of work qualifies for RAC Bucks?* Helping set up or take down our 3D shoots, doing registration or concessions at a 3D shoot, helping with spring cleanup or helping closing the range before winter, helping with our awards banquet or our flea market. Serving on the board of directors or helping with our Family Fun night. Building or repairing target butts, or bow hangers. Mowing, maintaining the perimeter fence, any of the grounds-keeping duties. Being the newsletter editor or serving as field captain. Maintaining club big game records, creating promotional flyers for 3D shoots or kid's shoots, or maintaining the clubs web site.

*What can I do with RAC Bucks?* You can use them to pay "**up to half**" of your club dues each year, you can use them to pay "**up to half**" of shooting fees or dinner tickets for our Awards Banquet. You can also buy additional chances in our drawing for fall hunting on the club property or you can use the in a special auction (only RAC \$ can be used) where we auction off the right to hunt on the club property during the fall.

Here's the fine print – RAC Bucks are printed in five dollar increments, you can use RAC Bucks for up to half of most things the club sells including membership dues. RAC Bucks do expire (there's an expiration date printed on the RAC Bucks), it is the members responsibility to collect RAC Bucks that he or she is due after working an event. ONLY RAC bucks can be used for hunting on the club property drawing or auction (sorry your real money isn't any good for this drawing or auction).
